UKS2 – Relationship, Sex and Health Education – Wednesday 24th June 2026

Dear Parents/Carers,

All schools are statutorily required to teach Relationships and Health Education but not necessarily Sex Education. At All Saints C of E Primary School we have followed The Equality Act 2010 and recommended DfE guidance and have decided that it is important to include a sex education programme tailored to the age and the physical and emotional maturity of our pupils in each year group. We believe that these lessons serve to protect and prepare the children in our school for their future lives as global citizens who are able to make responsible and informed choices.

The children in Year 5 and 6 will be having their 'RSHE – Relationship, Sex and Health Education' lessons in school on:

Wednesday 24th June

As part of the KS2 curriculum, we block these lessons across a half day during the latter part of each school year.

Year 5 pupils will complete a mini project pack split into girl talk and boy talk covering: **teenage problems, relationships with parents and mood swings, puberty, menstruation and hygiene.**

Year 6 pupils will complete a mini project pack all about: **how babies are made, a revision of puberty covered in year 5, grown up relationships and how they are different to friendships, what it is like being pregnant, looking after a baby and the responsibilities entailed.**

Pupils not participating in RSHE lessons will be provided with alternative work to complete independently outside of the classroom. However, before writing an official letter asking for your child to be removed from this RSHE learning, we would like to invite parents to view any videos and content pupils will be exposed to as part of their age-appropriate project.

A viewing session starting from 3.30pm-3.40pm for parents will be held on:

Wednesday 10th June in St Martha with Mrs Brackenbury (yr 6)
Wednesday 10th June in St George with Miss Kaye & Miss Burgess (yr 5)

We very much hope that you are happy for your child to take part in this RSHE learning and wish to emphasise to you as parents that if your child's teacher/phase leader does not hear from you before the day on which these lessons are due to take place, we shall take this as your consent for your child to participate in them.
