Dear Parents and Carers,

We are pleased to share some exciting reading initiatives taking place across the school. Reading is fundamental to every child's learning, and we are committed to fostering a love of books, improving fluency and comprehension, and celebrating the progress each child makes along the way.

To support this, we will be introducing a range of incentives and celebrations across all key stages. Children using Accelerated Reader in KS1 will collect online badges, while those in KS2 will earn certificates as they progress through the programme. We will also be displaying monthly snapshots of the number of words read on classroom doors, alongside our Reading Trophy, awarded to one class in each phase. The class with the highest number of words read will receive the trophy, helping to encourage healthy competition and a shared enthusiasm for reading.

We are also delighted to introduce our Millionaires' Club. Has your child read one million words? This exciting award celebrates children who reach this milestone through successful quizzes and sustained reading. As quiz scores contribute to the word count, gaining 100% is particularly important, as only correctly recorded words are counted. In addition, our 100% Board will recognise pupils who have exceeded or met their targets, or who have achieved 100% in their quizzes. Each time a child's name is displayed, they will receive a raffle ticket, and one winner each week will be chosen during celebration of worship to select a book as their prize. The class with the highest number of pupils achieving 100% in their quiz will also win a beach trip at the end of the year.

Further to this, a parental report outlining your child's achievement in quizzes will be sent home shortly. We are also introducing Reading Champions roles across each key stage. Pupils will be selected for these roles because of their enthusiasm for reading and their ideas for how we can continue to improve reading across the school. As part of the selection process, we would encourage children to write a short review of a recent book they have read or create a poster promoting reading. Peer recommendations are a powerful way to inspire others, and we believe these roles will help us build an even stronger reading community.

We would be very grateful for your continued support in encouraging your child to read regularly and to approach reading with enthusiasm. Your interest and encouragement at home make a significant difference, and we value your partnership in helping every child become a confident, committed reader.
